Important Information

There is no booking fee for accommodation. Our accommodation charges are for 7 nights (with the exception of hotels), arriving Sunday and departing Sunday. Most homestays, hotels and private apartments can be booked for a minimum of one week. However, Chapter Living requires a minimum of a four week stay. You can easily extend your accommodation after you arrive: please speak to the friendly accommodation team. We sometimes use agencies to help us find extra accommodation in the summer, but our team will organise everything for you. Rooms are subject to availability. We can arrange for you to share a room with a friend, provided you book for identical dates and both of you are studying at the school.

Visas & British Immigration Regulations

If you are a non-EU applicant, you may require a student visa in order to study at the school. It is your responsibility to obtain this visa and IH London is not responsible if a student obtains the wrong visa. If you require a visa, and you arrive without one, you will not be allowed to attend the school.

- > International House London is a Tier 4 Sponsor under the UKVI's points based system (no. 5BY3ENNA5).
- > International House London will provide the documentation required for participants to apply for study visas where applicable.
- > Documentation in support of study visa applications will only be provided upon receipt of full fees.
- > The school has a legal obligation to collate and maintain application information, as well as passport and visa data, and inform the Immigration Authorities of those participants whose attendance falls below the standard required by their visa.
- > If a visa application is unsuccessful, yet all documentation was correctly submitted, IH London needs to be informed and a copy of the visa refusal letter should be sent to the admissions team. A refund will be issued when we receive this document, providing that it is at least 14 days before the start of the course. If we are notified fewer than 14 days in advance, we will refund all fees except a £50 admin fee. We will also keep one week of accommodation fees.
