If you book your programme at International House London through an agency in your country, then the contract you have is with your agent, and different terms and conditions may apply.

Registration Fee

IH London charges a Registration Fee for all English courses. This covers all of your class materials so you don't need to bring anything but yourself! The cost of the Registration fee is £95. For any participants extending their course or returning within a 6 month period, there is no further fee. Insurance (Endsleigh Insurance) £6 per week.

Before you book

Payment

- > All fees are payable in advance.
- > Prices are for courses booked after 1 November 2017 for any course starting in 2018. Any courses commencing in 2017 or extensions to courses commencing in 2017 will still use 2017 prices.
- > If you wish to cancel, change or postpone your booking, we need 21 days' notice from your course start date. See Cancellation & Refund Policy for details.
- > If you wish to pay by international bank transfer, International House London works in partnership with Pay To Study to ensure that your payment is securely transferred with no fees. You pay in your local currency to a local account, and International House receives the correct amount. See ihlondon.paytostudy.com

Visas & British Immigration Regulations

If you are a non-EU applicant, you may require a student visa in order to study at the school. It is your responsibility to obtain this visa and IH London is not responsible if a student obtains the wrong visa. If you require a visa, and you arrive without one, you will not be allowed to attend the school.

- > International House London is a Tier 4 Sponsor under the UKVI's points based system (no. 5BY3ENNA5).
- > International House London will provide the documentation required for participants to apply for study visas where applicable.
- > Documentation in support of study visa applications will only be provided upon receipt of full fees.
- > The school has a legal obligation to collate and maintain application information, as well as passport and visa data, and inform the Immigration Authorities of those participants whose attendance falls below the standard required by their visa.
- > If a visa application is unsuccessful, yet all documentation was correctly submitted, IH London needs to be informed and a copy of the visa refusal letter should be sent to the admissions team. A refund will be issued on receipt of this document, less a £95 administration fee. We will also keep one week of accommodation fees if we are notified fewer than 21 days from the start of the course.

Important Information

- > Minimum age for participants on Learn English programmes is 16 years old.
- > You can start a Learn English course any week.
- > The minimum booking duration for Learn English 15, 20 and 25 courses is 2 weeks. Other courses offer specific course durations.
- > You need to be at least A2 level to study in the Learn English group classes except for the beginners course or on 1:1 training.
- > The registration fee of £95 is payable for all new enrolments.

If you start your next course within 6 months of your last course, this fee will not be charged.

Important Information
 There is no booking fee for accommodation. Our accommodation charges are for 7 nights (with the exception of hotels), arriving Sunday and departing Sunday. Most homestays, hotels and private apartments can be booked for a minimum of one week. However, Chapter Living requires a minimum of a four week stay. You can easily extend your accommodation after you arrive: please speak to the friendly accommodation team.
