Online units on the Cambridge CELTA Online course site are ‘opened’ every Sunday, and you can do the work during the following week. Work through the units and join the discussion forums the Online tutor sets up. The units have tasks attached to them: we ask you to complete and submit one task per week. There is an online tutor to guide you during the course.

Seminars are on Zoom and may take place **in different weeks**. The tutor will tell you of any changes.

Teaching Practice (TP) 18:30 – 20:30 These sessions are live on **Zoom**.

You need to be in a quiet private space on your laptop or desktop computer so you can teach the lessons, observe and participate in the discussion.

Feedback (FB) 20:30 – 21:00

Supervised Lesson Planning (SLP) 21:00 – 21:30

Attendance of seminars and teaching practice is compulsory.

Please note, assignments may be covered in a slightly different order, or deadlines vary, the tutor will inform you of any adaptations.

You will get access to the CELTA Online course site in the first week. The tutor will send you a welcome email with the link for the first zoom session a day before the course starts.

When you have booked your course, you will be given access to the Teacher Portal with pre-CELTA preparation materials to study. This will help you be well prepared for your course.
