Levels 1 - 16

These are our standard group courses allowing students to progress up through the levels. Classes are held at evenings and weekends and offer the opportunity for regular and convenient study.

Pre-holiday

Our short Pre-holiday courses are designed for complete beginners and offer preparation in the language and cultural insights ready for holidays and short business trips.

Introduction to

Our 10 week Introduction courses are ideal for students who have never studied that language before and want to ease their way in before taking the full plunge. Classes go at a more relaxed pace than our Level 1 courses and are a great taster to the language. Upon completion, students who wish to continue can progress to level 2.

Conversation Classes

Our Conversation Classes are aimed at Intermediate and Advanced students, and are a fun way to practise and improve fluency and pronunciation whilst engaging in interesting, cultural topics.

Sunday Club

Our Sunday Club is a fun way to share a passion for languages and cultures. During the course students have the opportunity to explore a variety of topics through interactive and communicative activities; special attention will also be paid to refining pronunciation and intonation to sound more like a native. The course is designed for those who are at intermediate and advanced level.
