**Type:** Studio room: £415 per person per week.

**Age:** 18 and over.

**Travel to IH London:**

**Facilities:** On-site gym, exercise studio, study space, games area, cinema room, social space, courtyard.

**Internet:** Up to 200MB, dual-band, free Wi-Fi throughout the residence.

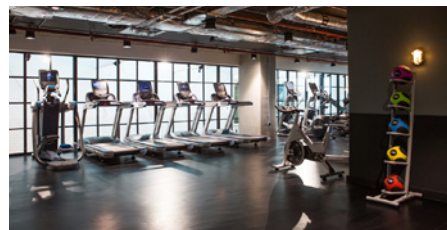
**Utilities:** All utility bills inclusive.

**Meal options:** Self-catering (own kitchenette).

**Security:** 24/7 on-site team, CCTV outside and inside, electronic photo swipe-card entry.

**Laundry:** Washing machine and dryers are available. There is a small charge for this provision.

**Linen:** Bed linen provided. Please bring your own towels.



**Chapter Living King's Cross** student residence had a complete refurbishment in 2017 and is a very modern and popular place for students to stay. It is located close to King's Cross station (only two stops to Holborn station, which is within easy walking distance of IH London). All rooms are en-suite and equipped with kitchenettes and ample storage.

#### Type of accommodation

Chapter Living King's Cross is a self-catered halls of residence.

#### Kitchen

Each kitchenette has a hob, kettle and microwave and included within your price is the use of a kitchen pack, which includes all of the kitchen utensils you will require to prepare your meals.

#### Rooms

The rooms are stylish, spacious and well designed with modern furnishings, some with amazing views of central London that you won't ever get tired of waking up to.

#### Bathrooms

En-suite bathrooms are available in all rooms.

#### Utilities

All utilities are included in the accommodation fee.

#### Communal facilities

There are many excellent facilities. The central lobby is a great meeting area for friends and has Wi-Fi access throughout. There is a gym that is free to use (after waiver form signed at reception). The courtyard is located just off the lobby and is a great space to hang out for you and your friends. The Chapter Living team use this space to hold a variety of social events for

all students, e.g. BBQ's and themed parties. There is a games space with table football, table tennis and pool, as well as ample quiet study space.

#### Internet and phone

There is Wi-Fi available in communal areas and in rooms.

#### Laundry and cleaning

Self-service laundry facilities are available for an extra charge per wash and per use of the dryer. Room cleaning is available on request and comes with an extra charge.

#### Security

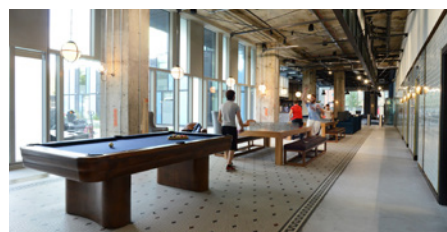
Chapter Living student accommodation operates an Electronic swipe-card entry system with the ability to match key card to a photo of the resident. There are also 24-hour security staff with multiple security monitoring rooms, CCTV outside and inside of the building.

#### Linen

Bed linen is provided at no extra charge. Students are responsible for washing their own linen.

#### Bookings

Minimum four weeks, and two weeks during the summer months. Sunday to Sunday.
