

THE LOCATION

IH Frensham Young Learner Centre is held in a private boarding school with excellent sports facilities and a theatre for music and performing arts, in the heart of Surrey countryside, South East England.


Frensham Common is owned by the National Trust and is a site of special interest.

Frensham Little Pond was created in the 13th century, when King Henry III was on the English throne. It was built to supply fish to the Bishop of Winchester.

The school has traditional academic buildings within impressive grounds, surrounded by beautiful woodland. It also features tree house classrooms.

The fantastic facilities include tennis courts, heated swimming pool, high ropes adventure course, its own theatre, dance studio and a new music department.

The school sits between South Downs National Park and the Surrey Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.



Half-day trips include Winchester Planetarium and Windsor Castle.

In the evenings, Discover English students will have an activity programme with a mix of sports, art and crafts, and other activities such as quizzes and film night.

Course content

Course content

This course features 21 hours of STEM classes and project work each week. It is designed to help students improve their everyday English as well as their knowledge of science and technology.

Within their STEM classes, students will look at the big questions facing scientists and technology tycoons today. Will space tourism become the norm? What will replace bullet trains and driverless cars in the future? Is sustainability a realistic objective for society?

This will lead into practical sessions with our partners Lego Education where students get hands-on experience building and programming a LEGO® MINDSTORMS® EV3 to solve challenges.

Students will also have the opportunity to develop their very own mobile app or game. The aim will be to solve a gap in the market or social issue. Students will present their apps and games at the end of the final week.

Students will also enjoy half-day and full-day excursions to a site or city of interest including a visit to the Science Museum in London, London walking tour, Winchester Planetarium, Windsor Castle, and Brighton with a ride on the Brighton i360.



On a full-day excursion to London students take a boat cruise along the Thames, from Greenwich to South Bank, followed by a royalty and politics walking tour. Discover English students go on a Shrek Adventure and STEM students visit the Science Museum.

BRIGHTON

Brighton is one of the most famous and popular seaside towns in England. Students will walk on Brighton Pier, ride on the i360 (a glass viewing pod that glides up gently to 450ft for stunning views) and visit the unique independent shops and cafés in The Lanes.

Stonehenge is one of the wonders of the world and the best-known prehistoric monument in Europe. Students can explore this English Heritage site and visit the exhibition centre featuring 250 ancient objects and a 5,500 year-old man.






