The opportunity to study online with a central London school, wherever you are, while developing soft skills and working towards a business plan presented at the end of the course. This course is for students who have a B2 level of English and want to develop other, soft skills such as debating and negotiating while studying in English and working towards a project.

Location: Online

Language level: B2+

Age Range: 14-17

Course length: 2/3 weeks (see sample programmes)

Course content

The course runs like an online conference, with students enjoying an exciting programme of expert webinars, practical tasks and guest speakers.

As part of our immersive learning philosophy, students take part in collaborative projects that not only maximise their language activation, but also require critical thinking, resourcefulness and team work.

Participants will work in groups via breakout rooms and use shared online portals to build a business plan for a social enterprise that will benefit their local or global community.

They learn about how to start a business, considering funding and financing, as well as writing a business plan. They pitch their business to a panel of judges on the final day of the course using both visual materials and sharing the online speaking 'floor'.

Learning outcomes

Students will:

- Develop a range of core skills and learning strategies required for academic and career success
- Develop techniques to express themselves powerfully in English and present with confidence
- Discover what it takes to be an entrepreneur and learn the principles of setting up a business and bringing a product to market
- Enhance interpersonal skills and broaden vocabulary
- Master the four Cs of 21st Century Skills – Collaboration, Critical thinking, Creativity and Communication
- Network and make new friends from around the world
- Be prepared for studying in an English-speaking environment
- Be prepared for working in an English-speaking environment
- Be introduced to negotiation skills
- Write a business plan and pitch their ideas to a panel
- Take part in a virtual business simulation project
