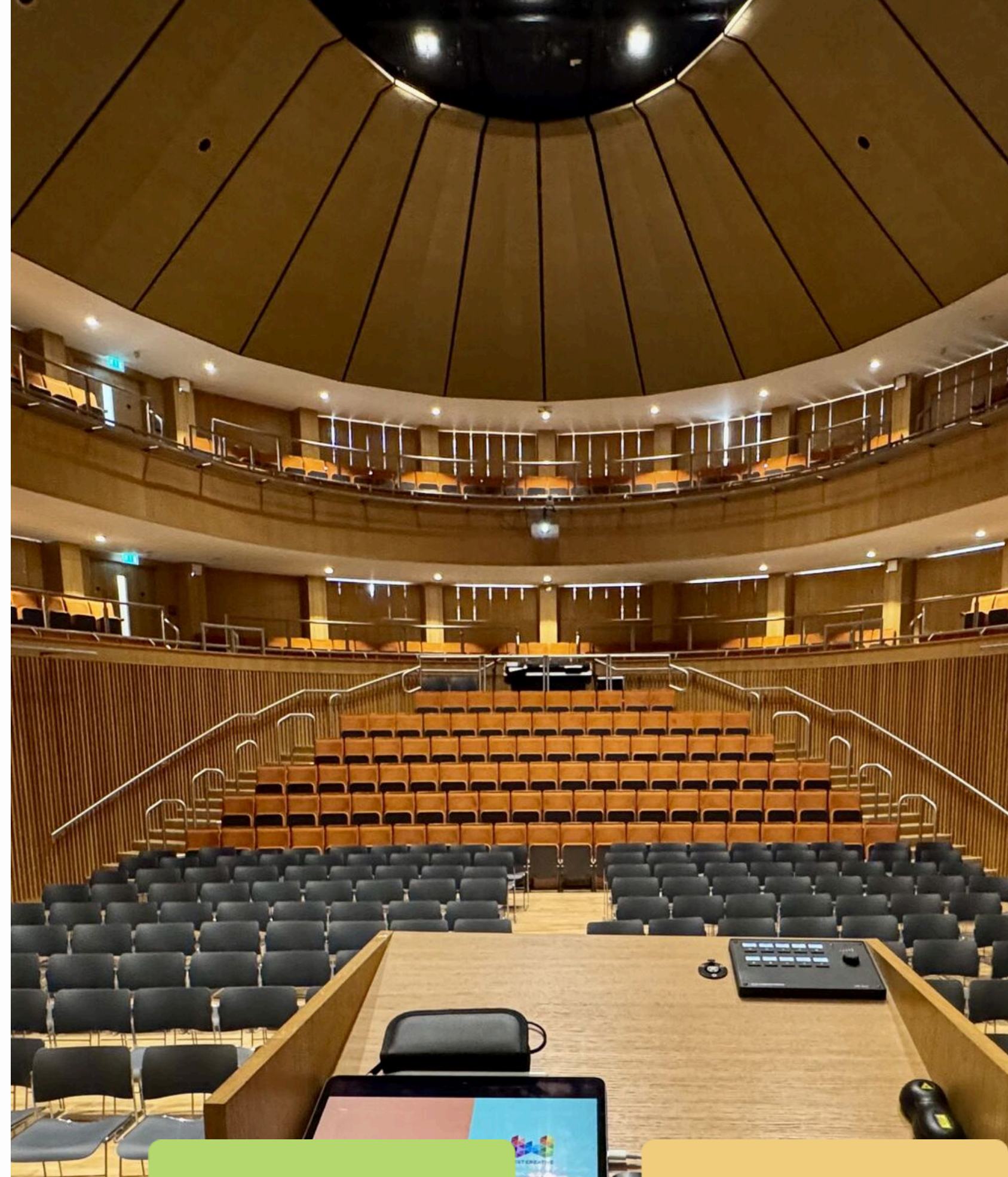

Future Leaders: Entrepreneurship is a 25-hour-per-week project-based programme designed for students aged 14–17 with a B2 level or above. Delivered in a conference-style format, the course blends highly interactive workshops, inspiring guest speaker sessions, and group challenges to build business knowledge, leadership skills, and creative problem-solving. At the end of the programme, students pitch ideas in the award-winning Olivier Hall and take part in a curated visit to Bletchley Park, all while engaging with an international peer group in a mature, university-style learning environment.
